

As the 2022-2023 school year comes to an end, I couldn't be more proud of the support the GAPS team and its partners provided for the students, staff, and families of the Gary Community School Corporation!

Thank you to the GAPS Board, GAPS Team, GCSC administration, staff, students, and families and the Gary community for your service and commitment to the mission of GAPS by connecting alumni, businesses, and community stakeholders with students to promote successful academic, career, and life outcomes.

We began the school year with a successful 2-day Career Fair in which we partnered with close to 40 vendors to immerse the West Leadership Academy 9th-12th grade students with college and career opportunities in and around the Gary community. We quickly moved into our *B.O.S.S.* programming for our high school students who participated in weekly workshops facilitated by over 10 partners!

Simultaneously, we launched our *L.I.T.* after-school program for close to 325 of our elementary and middle school students. 
