Scholarship (GFS) Fund was established to honor the <u>legacy of Mary and Willie Guthrie</u>.
Both were raised in Lithonia, GA, the children of sharecroppers, and both were the first in their large families to attend college.

The young family moved north in 1953 to escape racism and settled in Gary, IN where they spawned a multi-generational, extended family of achievers.

The Guthrie Family Collective (GFC) honors the legacy of their parents, Mary and Willie Guthrie by annually providing \$2,000 in financial support and mentoring to graduating seniors of African American descent from Gary (IN) West Side Leadership Academy and South Haven (MI) High School. Son, Carlton Guthrie is a founding member of the GAPS organization.
